THE FAIRFIELD ARTS COUNCIL (FAC) announced that the organization has received \$150,000 in Connecticut surplus funds. The funding, dispersed through the Directed Local Grants program of the **Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism Arts Division**, will be used to launch a new regional arts and culture alliance and strengthen the cultural district in Fairfield as well as grow the capacity of FAC.
